We ask that children bring in a board game, which will be played in an extended Golden Time on the Friday afternoon, along with a suggested minimum 50p donation.

All monies will go directly to NSPCC. Raising just £25 could pay for toys which children use during therapy sessions to explain how they are feeling. £100 could pay for a practitioner delivering 4 hours of group work helping children who have been affected by domestic abuse. Whatever we raise, we'll be helping to keep children safe.

*\*Please note that we are going to be trialling some drop-in sessions of lunchtime clubs up until summer, in preparation for the next school year. We have a small variety of board games/Lego, etc. for these clubs.*

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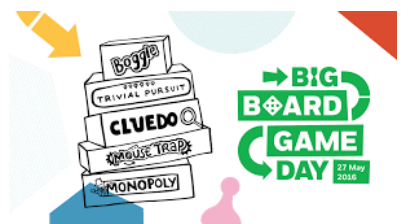
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
